'A REAL LIFEGUARD HAD TO SAVE ME FROM DROWNING!'

David Hasselhoff is the only surviving original cast member of Baywatch and he's the producer.

Here he tells GILL PRINGLE how his first day on the mega-show was nearly his last...

OTHING will erase the memory of my first episode of Baywatch - I nearly drowned! It's not the sort of thing a lifeguard is meant to do.

We were filming in a dolphin park in Hawaii and I was in a tank with the dolphins when I hit my head on some of the scenery and was knocked unconscious beneath the water.

Everything went blank. I just remember a vague floating sensation. Fortunately, Baywatch has always hired a lot of real lifeguards to look after us when we're doing water scenes. One of the guys hauled me out of the water, pumped my chest and gave me mouth-to-mouth resuscitation.


They should have filmed the whole incident! It would have made great live action material!

I thought Baywatch was just some silly beach boy story when I was first offered the project in 1989, after I'd starred in Knight Rider. I recall saying to my manager, 'Look, I don't really want to do this, This is basically Knight Rider in a bathing suit'.

Neither was I real confident about wearing a bathing suit because I'm so tall and lanky. I was not blessed with the world's perfect body.

"It's not so bad now, I work out, but believe me, I've worked hard at building this body, and it's nowhere near perfect. I've got these long racehorse legs which go well in jeans, but not in a bathing suit. I thought, 'Jesus Christ! This is going to be embarrassing, running around in a bathing suit'.

But my manager persuaded me to have a meeting with the TV network. They showed me this video



montage of what Baywatch wa all about, featuring helicopter and boats and people on the beach It was done so well, so exciting, and so MTV with a California lood to it. I got in my car and called my manager and told him, 'I wan this project'. The next thing I knev I was on a plane to Hawaii to filn the very first Baywatch in 1989 which was called Panic At Malibi Pier. The whole story was mean to take place in Malibu.

But because we were filming in winter, the water there was freezing and all of us spoiled actors refused to work in the cold Pacific Ocean

We spent seven days doing all the water scenes on location in Hawaii and then 14 more days back in Los Angeles filming around Malibu and Santa Monica. It was a great cast of people actors like Parker Stevenson Erika Eleniak and Billy Warlock were all in this first spisode.

One of the plot lines involved the troubled kid who jumps off the pier and ends up becoming obsesses with the lifeguard who rescues her

The most amusing thing that happened on our first episode was when the producers called in a local Hawaiian spiritual leader called a Kahuna, to bless the series

He came out on to the beach and started chanting and offering up all these prayers to the Gods, but he kept going on, and on and on. The entire blessing went on for about 45 minutes, and the producers kept looking at their watches. That blessing put us behind schedule for the whole of the week, but maybe that's why we've had such good luck. Who knows?

YASMINE LETS HER GUARD DOWN FOR LOVE!

Forget the freezing water and the rumours of rivalry on the Baywatch set, what's making Yasmine Bleeth really tremble is the prospect of getting to the altar on time, as she tells LINDA UDALL ...

N a beach full of blonde babes, gorgeous brunette Yasmine Bleeth was a welcome breath of fresh air when she joined the cast of Baywatch

almost two years ago. Since then she has endured endless rumours of rivalry between herself and co-star Pamela Anderson, not to mention severe bouts of ear infection due to filming in the polluted sea off Santa Monica.

And she's trying to find time to plan her wedding!

The stories are more unfair on Pamela than on me," insists Yasmine, 27, who recalls one particularly lurid tale which claimed Pamela stormed into her dressing room and ordered Yasmine to stay away from her men.

She is always portrayed in this horrible light, making her seem like she's the queen bitch who's jealous of me. Such rivalry simply doesn't exist. Pamela is very kind and open with me," she says.

"I've also had to take time off from the set, which delayed filming, because of having car infections after filming in the dirty water here. It's freezing in December and the water is cold and filthy. I don't complain when I'm in there but when I have had enough I tell them I can't take it any more and I get out of the water.

"I don't let them push me into doing any more than I can take. I've been through it all in my two years on Baywatch, and I've survived," says Yasmine, who plays Caroline Holden, the naive younger sister of Lt Stephanie Holden, played by Alexandra Paul. "Now life couldn't be better.

Yasmine has had to endure endless separations from her fiance, soap star Ricky Paull Goldin, who works most of the time in New York. But the couple are set to marry this coming New Year's Eve

Having previously dated Beverly Hills 90210 star Luke Perry and Melrose Place hunk Grant Show, she reckons she is finally ready to settle down, "I can't wait to be married Ricky Paull and I have been together for four years now, and there's never been any doubt in my head that I wanted to be his wife," she says, "We're going to be married in Manhattan

in a private townhouse, a little like a country club. It's scary right now because although I've got most of it planned,

there's lots of details I haven't got round to fixing. I have my dress picked out and my bridesmaids, but there's so much more to do, like organising the flowers.

I'm hoping it will snow because that would be really beautiful."

Ricky Paull proposed by getting down on bended knee and doing it the traditional way while the couple were on holiday in the Bahamas earlier this year.

"It was so completely unexpected," said Yasmine. "He was as old-fashioned about it as you can imagine. I was completely taken off guard because although we'd discussed marriage, we'd never really said we were going to actually marry

We'd both like a family eventually, although I want to give myself a little more time until I'm really ready to devote myself to my children.

Romantic Ricky is planning their honeymoon, and is insisting on keeping the destinution a secret from his bride,

"It's going to be a big surprise," says Yasmine. I think I would like to go to the South Pacific, but he's not going to tell me until we're on our way to the airport. The deal is, I plan the wedding, and he plans the honeymoon."

Yasmine will shortly appear on the cover of Playboy magazine, despite having turned down a £60,000 offer to grace its centrefold earlier this year

Unlike fellow Baywatch babes Pamela Anderson and Erika Eleniak, who bared all for the magazine, she got to keep her clothes on. "I couldn't resist the opportunity," giggles Yasmine, 27, "I went to the Playboy mansion, dressed up in those wonderful bunny costumes,

ol dressed up as a Playboy Bunnygirl for my video role as a wild child!

drank champagne and met Hugh Hefner. Such a lovely man!"

Yasmine's fee was a lot less than the original £60,000 she was offered - because she makes her Playboy debut in a video

for hit pop band The Rembrandts.
"I'd agreed to do the video for their new song, This House Is Not A Home Without You, before I even knew the story idea. I play a wild kid, who skips off to the Playboy mansion the moment my parents have left the house. There I lead another life, hanging out and drinking champagne.

"They took a copy of Playboy from the Fifties and superimposed me on the cover. In those days, there was hardly any nuclity in the magazine so I get the cover of Playboy AND keep my clothes on, Great!"

A child model who went on to star in two major US soaps, Yasmine is used to being in the public eye. But if there's one thing she can't stand, it's people talking about her behind her back

"It's great to be recognised, but I do wish people would come and say 'Hi' to me, rather than talking about me like

I'm deaf or stupid," she says,
"Sometimes I'm in a store, and people will talk about you like you're not there, like you can't hear them. Believe me, I have radar ears when I hear them go, 'It's the girl from Baywatch!' Yes, it's me! Say hello! Talk TO me, rather than ABOUT me.

"I don't think Baywatch has really changed me. This business affects people when they gain recognition overnight, whereas I've been doing it since I was a child so there was no problem.

In one recent Baywatch episode, Yasmine's character turns bad girl and goes off with a rough and ready biker.

"After I'd read the script I came home and said to Ricky Paull, 'Ugh, I've got to kiss some stranger. I wish it was you, you'd be perfect.' I mentioned it the next day on the set, and he was hired to do it!

"We got to ride Harleys together and it was quite fun. It worked out well for us, and it meant I didn't have to kiss anyone other than my fiance

And as for a perfect break from Baywatch? "In bed relaxing with Ricky." she says. "Shut the blinds, switch off the phone, watch a movie and eat chocolate escape from the world for a day.

Baywatch hunk Jaason Simmons finally admits his secret love affair in an exclusive interview with GILL PRINGLE...

AYWATCH hunk Juason Simmons has opened his heart for the first time to Yes! magazine about his secret love affair with TV co-star Alexandra Paul. Married Simmons, 25, has kept their steamy romance a secret while he tried to figure out the best way to break the news to his estranged wife Romey, 37.

Jaason, who plays bad boy Logan Fowler in the world's number one TV series, and Alexandra, 31, who plays Leutenant Stephanie Holden, were equally at pains to keep their love a secret after Baywatch producer David Hasselhoff warned the cast against getting involved with one another off screen.

But when Jaason and Alexandra threw a joint birthday party recently their love for one another became obvious to the rest of the cast and crew, and it was only a matter of time before their secret would come out.

The couple kissed and cuddled, and at one time Jasson squeezed Alexandra's burn affectionately, while she was later seen sitting on his lap, nuzzling her face into his neck.

"I was worried that our love would be seen as one of those tacky affairs so often portrayed in the supermarket tabloids. But this is a profound love which goes much deeper than an affair," says Tasmanian-born Jaason, who is a great believer in spirituality and destiny. "I am totally in love," he declares.

Everyone experiences these things and life
goes on. It's hardly a scandal to fall in
love with someone with whom you work.
I still have feelings for my wife, and
there are no plans for divorce.

"Because Baywatch has made overnight stars out of all the cast, an innocent love affair can become exaggerated until it reaches Hugh Grant proportions. It all seems to silly," says Jaason, who received a stern talking-to from Hasselhoff after the gossip began.

He has also had to explain himself to estranged wife Romey who believed there was no-one else involved when the couple

separated earlier this year.

Janson and Mexican-born Romey married in 1993, after meeting four years earlier on a flight across America.

"When we first got together, we had nothing and I was working as a porter. But things changed and I guess I have to face up to the fact that my marriage is over," admits the actor.

"A lot of things start happening when you work on a series like this, and it's not fair on anyone in your personal life. I'm hardly ever at home.

"We married when I had nothing, and we were going to go back to Australia and

live there together - then all of a sudden Baywatch happened. There's no use fighting this thing. I chose this crazy lifestyle.

"But there's so much more to this job than people think. They think it's just messing around and acting, but this is one of the most publicised shows ever, and in our contracts we have to do X amount of publicity tours.

"Romey came on some of the trips with me but it wasn't always possible. It can be a big strain.

"She was working double-shifts at Burbank Airport. I would get up at 5am to go to the Baywatch set while she was asleep. And when I would come back from work, she would have gone to work, so we just never saw each other.

"I don't regret any of my decisions - I do believe that things work out the way they're meant to work out. We're still married but not living together," he says.

Jaason turned to Alexandra to help him deal with his heartbreak. He has also formed a strong friendship with Baywatch newcomer David Chokachi.

"But there's not an evening that goes by that I don't speak to Alexandra on the phone. She is my mentor and my confidante, and always has the best advice to give to me," he says.

"She has her head on straight and talks a lot of sense to me. It's good to have that one person that you can trust to tell you the truth. She's a totally beautiful person."


Gentle Juason may play Baywatch's bad guy but beneath the tough exterior he admits he is a big softie who still grieves for the father he lost when he was nine years old.

In America he has been branded a rebel after having a tattoo etched on his upper arm.

But Jaason reveals that the tattoo is actually a homage to his late father, bearing his family's eagle, sun and shield crest and inscribed with the initials R H S Roger Haydn Simmons 1944-1979.

loved very much," he says as he chats during a break in filming for Baywatch. "This is my own private homage to my father, and it has been blown up into something else entirely.

"And besides, aren't bad guys meant to have tattoos? David Hasselhoff has never said a word about it. As far as I know, nobody is remotely bothered by my tattoo," he insists.

Jaason's beloved dad Roger died in Hobart 16 years ago after he developed brain tumours and was diagnosed with cancer.

Jaason and his sister Gina were raised by their mother Elizabeth and grandmother Miriam and later their mother remarried.

He bears testament to the three women in his life in another tattoo, on his left arm, incorporating their three initials.

"I had that tattoo done more than three years ago, and I said at the time that I would get one done to commemorate my father three years after – which is precisely what I did.

"In a way, it's because of my father's premature death that I became interested in acting. During his prolonged illness, I tried to live in a fantasy land as much as possible and found myself at the matinees all the time. I just wanted to escape reality, and then I realised that I could make a living doing it."

The only other family initials missing from Jaason's anatomy is that of his stepfather Robert.

"When my mother remarried, I gave my stepfather a lot of grief - the usual rebellious teenage stuff. We never used to get along at all, because I always felt he was trying to replace my dad, and I didn't want anyone to take his place.

"But it's taken a lot of distance and time to realise that all he ever wanted was the best for me. Everything that took place was out of parental concern. But when you're a brat like I was, you think the whole world's against you

the whole world's against you.

"It took a long time before I was able to tell my family how much I love them all. I took them for granted and it was only when I left that I realised how much I loved them," he confesses.

get me, I'm ready for anything", yet the private Pam speaks in a gentle voice and only has good things to say about everyone.

AVID Chokachi has a clean-cut image, welldeveloped muscles and pin-up good looks. And as if that's not enough, he's a real-life life-

"I worked as a sailing instructor for seven years," says the 28-year-old actor. "And I've lost track of the amount of people I've pulled out of the water.

"But it was no big deal. When I went sailing, I used to take kids out with me, and often, when it was really windy, they would get knocked into the water.

"I'd jump in and pull them out. You've got to be quick out at sea."

He's a man with plenty of strings to his bow. Before his acting career took off he worked for a year in politics, then became an overnight success as a model, appearing in commercials and fashion campaigns.

"Politics had been a big passion for me, but I enjoyed the modelling work and commercials so much and felt I had found my niche," he says.

If Chokachi's acting career in Hollywood got off to a shaky start 22 months ago, it's because his arrival coincided with the January 1994 earthquake, which measured 6.9 on the Richter scale.

The quake, however, opened up an opportunity to Chokacki who began work as a federal disaster inspector three days after the tremor, inspecting damaged buildings and assessing the costs. "I'd worked in construction back East so I was pretty familiar with buildings and structure.

"I would take a hand-held computer around the worst-hit areas and assess the damage."

A year later, he walked into a Baywatch auditon with 200 hunky bodybuilders, and won his coveted role as Cody, a world-class Olympic swimming hopeful who supplements his training while working as a Baywatch lifeguard.

And if the camera lingers too closely on Chokachi's splendid physique, then you will see the battle sears of his own real-life athletic background.

"I broke my femur in eighth grade in football and spent seven weeks in hospital in traction," he says.

"I'm literally covered in lacerations and there are sears everywhere where I had stitches. I have some real good sears on my arms and a couple in my lip. Years of playing sports will do that to you.

"Most of the lacerations in my face have been acquired from playing baseball.

"High-speed crashes in windsurfing and bouncing off the equipment doesn't help, likewise with mountain-biking when you're crashing in the woods all the time."

Today he keeps in trim by working out three hours a day, while at the weekend he snowskis, water-skis, mountain bikes or plays volleyball.

"During the week I run a lot and work out with weights and go boxing," says Chokachi.

"But I really am having a great time working on Baywatch - it's such fun."

Chokachi says that David Hasselhoff, who plays Mitch, loves to tease him about his Turkish name.

"He loves making fun of my name and finding new ways to pronounce it," says the new hoy

boy.

"His favourite is 'Choke-a-chicken'. It's hard to keep a straight face when someone is calling you that.

"David is always joking around. But he's been great a genuinely nice guy.

"He's always in a mad mood and he's brought the show to an incredible level of popularity.

"I've been made to feel so welcome. I may be one of the new people...but I feel completely at home already."
